## RETIREMENT ANNOUNCEMENT

Captain Travis Cunning will be retiring Canadian Armed Forces on 11 April 2008 after more than 15 years of service. He joined the Canadian Armed Forces in 2002 as a Royal Canadian Electrical and Mechanical Engineer (RCEME) Officer. He attended the Royal Military College in Kingston, ON and graduated in 2006 with a Bachelor's degree in Chemical Engineering.

Following graduation and upon the completion of his occupation training, he was posted to 3 Area Support Group Maintenance Company in Gagetown, New Brunswick, as the Workshop Group Officer and later as the Training Officer, and the Unit General Safety Officer. He then moved over to the Combat Training Centre Headquarters where he was promoted to the rank of Captain and placed in charge of the RCEME Training Design cell.

In 2011, he was selected for sponsored Post Graduate training and he returned to the Royal Military College, graduating in 2013 with a Master's degree specializing in Nuclear Engineering. He was then posted to the Directorate of Nuclear Safety in Ottawa, ON to put his newfound knowledge to good use. While there, he provided radiological and nuclear scientific support to DND units and operations, as well as to other government partners.

In the summer of 2016 he was posted to his current position in DSSPM as the Project Control Officer for the Integrated Soldier System Project. After completing an intensive PMCD boot camp, he got involved in many aspects of the project and learned a lot about Project Management, Defence Procurement, Contracting and much more.

After more than 15 years of service, Travis has accepted an offer to join the federal public service within DND. Upon retirement, he will take his uniform off, return to the Directorate of Nuclear Safety, and continue to work in his chosen field.
