Captain Alexandre Levesque will be retiring from Canadian Armed Forces on May 1st 2018 after 9 years of service within the Royal Canadian Electrical and Mechanical Engineer corps.

Captain Levesque enrolled at the Canadian Armed Forces Recruiting Center in Ottawa on June 27th 2008. He started his career at the Royal Military College of St-Jean in order to complete the first portion of his civil engineer bachelor degree. After his transfer to Royal Military College of Canada in Kingston in 2010, he completed his bachelor degree in civil engineering in April 2013. He then went to Canadian Forces Base Borden to complete the RCEME officer training that he started while at the college. When that training was completed during fall 2013, he was posted to Montreal to 202 Workshop Depot. He started as a project manager for the Resource Conservation and Infrastructure Maintenance Group and was then employed as the Operation Support Vehicle project manager where he took care, among others, of the LAV preparation for shipment to GDLS, upgrade project for Leopard 2 and return from R&O of Cougar. In May 2016, he was transferred to the Army Equipment Fielding Center as the Deputy Commanding Officer/Operations Officer.
