Capt Sébastien Oorlynck will be retiring on 13 June 2019, after 14 years of dedicated service to the Canadian Armed Forces (CAF) with the Corps of RCEME, in both the Regular Force and Reserve Force.

Capt Sébastien Oorlynck joined the CAF in June 2005 as a Reservist and subsequently transferred to the Regular Force under the Regular Officer Training Program (ROTP) in July 2006. After completing a Bachelor's Degree of Science in Mechanical Engineering at Ottawa University, he underwent phase training at the RCEME School and was posted to 2 Svc Bn Petawawa in 2010. During his tenure at 2 Svc Bn, he held the positions of Vehicle and Recovery Platoon Commander, Administration Officer, Battalion Training Officer, in addition to being employed as ODP 1.1 incremental staff during the summers of 2013 and 2014. In July 2014, he was posted to London as the 31 Service Battalion Technical Services Officer overseeing institutional support to 31 CBG, NAVRES, CFRC and lodger units throughout South Western Ontario.

In July 2016, he was posted to the RCEME School, CFB Borden where he occupied the Projects Officer, Regimental Company 2IC and Advance Training Platoon course development positions. Capt Oorlynck will be moving to St Joseph Island, Ontario with his wife Jessie and daughter Alexandra.
