CWO J.J.D. Dubuc, MMM, CD

After 34+ year of loyal service, CWO Dubuc will retire from the Canadian Armed Forces on 3 September 2019.

Chief Warrant Officer Dany Dubuc was born in Thetford Mines, Quebec. He enrolled in the Canadian Forces on 19 December 1984 as an electronic technician in the Electrical and Mechanical Engineering Branch. He completed his trade qualification in Borden at the Canadian Forces School Electrical and Mechanical Engineering.

In July 1986, he was posted to 202 Workshop Depot to complete his qualification level 4. In March 1987, he was posted to 5 Service Battalion Valcartier, Quebec. In August 1987 he was posted to 12 RBC.

He was promoted to the rank of Master Corporal in July 1991 and posted back to 5 Service Battalion as the electrical shop supervisor.

In July 1994, he was posted to the Canadian Forces School of Electrical and Mechanical Engineering as an instructor at the Artisan Company with the electronic and optronic platoon.

Promoted to the rank of Sergeant in July 1999, he was posted to 1 Canadian Field Hospital and was the supervisor of the ancillary section. In July 2003, he was promoted to the rank of Warrant Officer and posted back to Borden at the Canadian Forces School of Electrical and Mechanical Engineering and worked in the standards cell. In July 2005, he moved to the electronic and optronic platoon as the platoon warrant.

In July 2006, he was promoted to the rank of Master Warrant Officer and posted with 1st Battalion Royal 22e Regiment (1 R22eR) as Equipment Technical Quarter Master Sergeant (ETQMS) until December 2009. During his posting at 1 R22eR, he completed the high readiness training with the TF 4-06 and TF 1-09 to be deployed in Afghanistan with the National Support Element as the ETQMS and Company Sergeant Major (CSM).

In January 2010, he was deployed with OP Hestia in Haiti after the earthquake that destroyed a major part of this region.

In June 2010, he was promoted to the rank of Chief Warrant Officer and was posted to Ottawa as career manager for the Electrical and Mechanical Engineering branch for the material technicians, weapons technicians and the electronic and optronic technicians.

In June 2012, was posted to Petawawa as the Regimental Sergeant Major of 2 Service Battalion. In July 2015, CWO Dubuc became the 21st RCEME Corps Sergeant Major and in June 2016 became CFSU(O) CWO.

Chief Warrant Officer Dubuc has been married to Ann Dostie since 1991 and are the proud parents of Alexandra and Melanie.

Dany, Ann and the girls will remain in Gatineau until Ann retires in a couple of years, then move back to Thetford Mines and finally spend winters in Florida.
