## RETIREMENT MESSAGE



**Capitaine Roger Bolduc, CD**

After 37 years of loyal service in the Canadian Armed Forces and with the RCEME Corps, Captain Bolduc will retire on 5 July 2019.

Captain Roger Bolduc joined the CAF in April 1982 in the Primary Reserve. After completing his studies in 1989, he Component Transferred to the Regular Force as an Electrical Mechanical Engineer. He completed phase trg in 1990 and was subsequently posted to 5 Service Battalion in Valcartier, QC, where he worked as Maintenance Company Training Officer and Material Platoon Commander.

Posted to 202 Workshop in 1993, he worked as Training Officer and 2 IC Production in Building 3. In 1997, he was posted to DGLEPM/DASPM as Deputy Project Manager in the Light Gun project where he delivered the new LG1 and C3 105mm Howitzers. After three years in the project, he then became the Fuels, Oils, Lubricants and Paint LCMM for two years. He then spent two years in the Land Software Engineering Center and then returned to managing artillery equipment.

In 2005, he became the Deputy Project Manager for the M777 155mm Light Towed Howitzer, delivering the first gun to Afghanistan in 2006. He then deployed on Op Crocodile, the Congo, where he directly contributed his time during evenings and weekends, expanding the local community's capability in managing their own biological Cocoa plantations.

From 2012 to 2015, he was posted to Saint John, NB as RSS where he was employed as Operations Officer. He was then posted to ADM(Mat)/DGMSSC where he designed a database that identified the warehousing locations of all obsolete spare parts associated to all CAF major equipment (in service and obsolete) such as components for CF18, CF5, Halifax Class ships, tanks, RG-31, all vehicle types, weapons, LLAD, etc. Roger is finishing his career as the Adjutant of 5CDSG Technical Services.
