**Sgt J.B.B. Marceau, CD**

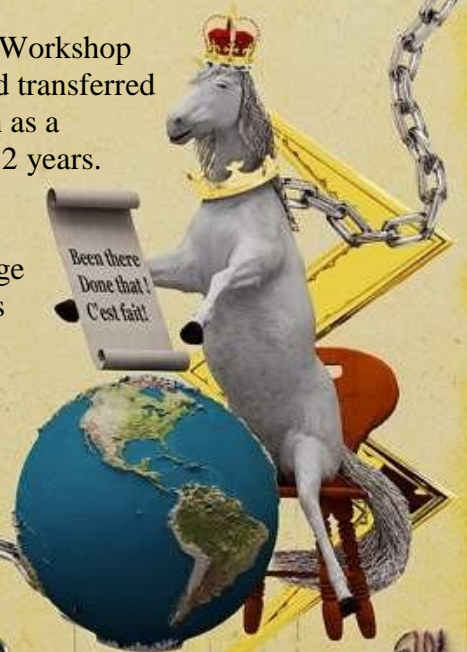
After 21 years of good and loyal service as a regular force member in the RCEME Corps, Sgt Marceau will retire on December 15, 2019. He was born in Montréal in 1978 and joined the Canadian Armed Forces in September 1998 as a vehicle technician.

In December 1998, he was posted to 5 Bon Svc (324). During this time he was deployed to Afghanistan for OP ATHENA from January 2004 to September 2004.

When he returned from his mission, he was posted to the 202<sup>nd</sup> Workshop Depot in Montréal. In July 2010 he was promoted to MCpl and transferred to St-Hubert as a supervisor. In 2012, he was posted to Borden as a technical instructor and section 2IC at the RCEME School for 2 years.

In July 2014, he was promoted to Sgt and transferred to 33 service battalion in Ottawa. During this period, he was in charge of maintenance for various reserve units. For 6 months, he was at the G4 of the 33<sup>rd</sup> brigade.

On June 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2017, he was posted to Svc Tech St-Hubert. He was attached to 34 Svc Bn where he assumed responsibilities of Production Sgt. In summer of 2018, he was
