**Cpl St-Pierre**

After more than 10 years of service in the Canadian Armed Forces and the Corps of Royal Canadian Electrical and Mechanical Engineers, Cpl Simon St-Pierre will retire on January 6th 2020.

Cpl St-Pierre was born in Ste-Anne-des-Monts in Gaspésie, in November 1988. In March 2009, after completing a DEP in automotive mechanics, Cpl St-Pierre decided to join the CAF in Rimouski. He began his career as a vehicle technician, in April 2009. Following the completion of his BMQ, he was loaded on his soldier qualification in October 2009. Shortly after, he began his DP1 in Borden in early 2010 and he was then posted to 5 Svc Bn in order to complete his DP1.2. He was promoted to corporal in February 2013. After completing his DP2 in May 2013, he was posted to Maint coy, 5 Svc Bn in Valcartier. There, he worked in 2nd line and also in 1st line when he was attached to St-Malo to work. For medical reasons, he was transferred to work in the Tool Crib of Maint coy in early 2017.

Simon plans to complete a course to become a security agent and work at the hospital in Ste-Anne-Des-Monts. He will begin the construction of a new house next spring with his spouse Catherine.
