Chief Warrant Officer René Tremblay

With more than 28 years of dedicated and loyal service to the Canadian Armed Forces, CWO René Tremblay will be retiring on the 27 March, 2018.

CWO Tremblay enrolled in Ottawa on the 3rd August 1989 as a Vehicle Technician. His first posting was with 2 Svc Bn Petawawa, Maintenance Coy. After returning from RV 92 he served with the Canadian Airborne Regiment until 1995. During his time with the CAR he had the privilege of being part of the 50th Anniversary of D Day in Normandy, a definite highlight in his career. Afterward he was posted to 1 Canadian Division Headquarters and Signal Regiment in Kingston, once promoted to MCpl in 1999 he was back to 2 Svc Bn Maintenance Coy in Petawawa. During his two year with 2 Svc Bn he deployed to KOSOVO with NSE. In 2001, he jumped into the SOF community for 8 years. As a Warrant Officer in 2009, he was posted to DGMPD and worked on the MSVS SEV shelter. The following year he was promoted to Master Warrant Officer. In 2013, back to Petawawa this time he proudly stepped in the ETQMS position with the RCD. In 2016, he was posted base side with 4 CDSB Tech Svcs in the Ops cell. Promoted to his current rank in 2017, CWO Tremblay was posted to DGLEPM/DSVPM as the Directorate Chief.

CWO Tremblay will remain in the Ottawa region where he will start the next chapter of his life as he continues to serve his country as a public servant in DGLEPM
