After 29 years of full time service in the Canadian Armed Forces and the Corps of Royal Canadian Electrical & Mechanical Engineers, Maj Glenn Barbour will retire on 26 March 2018. Originally from Winnipeg MB, Maj Barbour, joined the regular force as a Direct Entry Officer in March 1989 and upon completion of training was posted to Base Maintenance Gagetown.

While in Gagetown, from 1991 to 1996, he filled a number of roles within Base Maintenance and in the Base Technical Services HQ. His experiences included time as a Platoon Commander, a Group Commander, G4 Maintenance and the Adjutant of Technical Services. It was also during this time the he had the opportunity to complete a tour as the Maintenance Officer with the United Nations Disengagement Observer Force in Golan Heights, Israel.

In 1996, he moved on to become the Technical Adjutant of 1 RCHA and, subsequently, the CFB Shilo Base Maintenance Officer. In 1999, he finally decided that he needed some formal education so he went to Kingston to attend the Land Force Technical Staff Programme. On completion of the programme in 2000, he was posted to DGLEPM, where he served as an Assistant SEM in DAVPM and then the Integrated Logistics Systems Manager for the LUVW project.

From DGLEPM, in 2006, he was assigned to be the Liaison Officer with the US Army Tank and Automotive Command and after three years with the US Army, he returned to Canada in 2009 to serve as the CO of ASU London until 2011. Having another opportunity to work with the US Army, he then took the Liaison Officer position at US Army Test & Evaluation Command from 2011 to 2014.

In 2014, finally being recalled to Ottawa, he joined the Canadian Army HQ staff as G4 Plans 2 and in 2016 took up his final posting as the DCO of 4 CDSB Technical Services. Upon retirement from the CAF, he will be returning to Ottawa to take up a Public Service position within DGIIIP.
