CPL, JEAN-SÉBASTIEN DUCHESNE, VEHICLE TECHNICIAN

After more than 11 years of service in the Canadian Armed Forces, Cpl Jean-Sébastien Duchesne will retire on June 10, 2018. Jean-Sébastien was born in Chicoutimi, Quebec on June 1989. In February 2007, Cpl Duchesne decided to enlist in the Canadian Armed Forces in Chicoutimi as a vehicle technician. In 2008, he completed his BMQ in St-Jean and his BMQ-L in Valcartier. In early 2010, he completed his DP1 and was posted to 5 Svc Bn to complete his OJT. He was promoted to Cpl in 2011. He obtained several qualifications and then moved over to the 5 RALC in February 2012. After successfully completing his DP2 in November 2012, Cpl Duchesne was employed in the armored section as a MTVR driver. Subsequently, he held the position of 2IC heavy vehicle section. In 2014, he returned to 5 SVC BN with the EMM where he was mandated to assist front-line units and contributed to the operational capability of the Brigade.
