RETIREMENT MESSAGE
CPL JORDON HART, VEHICLE TECHNICIAN

On the 23rd of June 2018, Cpl Hart was retired after 9 years of service to the CAF and the RCEME Corps.

Cpl Hart joined the forces in Halifax, Nova Scotia at the age of 20, choosing to become a Vehicle technician. Upon completion of BMQ, Cpl Hart was posted to CFB Borden where he was quickly loaded on a SQ Course in CFB Gagetown. Completing his QL3 training in December 2010 meant Cpl Hart was off to CFB Edmonton to begin his OJT package. Luckily he was joined by friend and former course mate Jesse Goudreau which ultimately made the move out west much easier. During his OJT package Cpl Hart was trusted to operate as an MRT Commander on multiple occasions but notably during the flooding in Manitoba in 2011.

Cpl Hart's first (and only) real posting was to Administration Company in 1 Service Battalion in September 2012 where he was quickly course loaded to complete his QL5. Finishing in January of 2013 it wasn't long before he was off to assist in the High River flooding in the summer of 2013. Cpl Hart also participated in the Fire relief efforts in Northern Saskatchewan in 2015 as an MRT Commander. He was deployed to Adazi, Latvia in May 2017 to assist with initial set up for Op Reassurance.

Cpl Hart had his DWD at Beer Revolution in Edmonton on 15 June, 2018. Cpl Hart will be leaving the CAF to take on new challenges working as a Heavy Duty Mechanic for CN Rail. He and his wife Meaghan will be continuing to live in their new home in Stony Plain.
