RETIREMENT MESSAGE LIEUTENANT-COLONEL SHAWN D. MCLEAN, CD

Lieutenant-Colonel McLean has retired from the CAF after more than 34 years of loyal and dedicated service to Canada as a member of the RCEME Corps effective on 15 June 2018.

A native of Coburg Ontario, Lieutenant-Colonel McLean joined the Canadian Forces in 1984. He enrolled in the Regular Force under the Direct Entry Officer Programme upon graduation from St Lawrence College in Brockville, ON as an Electrical Engineering Technologist.

Commissioned as a Royal Canadian Electrical Mechanical Engineering Officer, Lieutenant-Colonel McLean has served in a variety of positions with both the Army and the Air Force. He deployed on a peacekeeping operation in Cyprus and has participated in a NATO peace support exercise as a brigade level staff officer in the Ukraine.

His other command and staff appointments of note include: Maint O, 2 RCR, CFB Gagetown; G4 Operations, LFAA HQ Halifax NS; Instructor and School Standards Officer, Canadian Forces School of EME, CFB Borden; Operations Officer and Company Second-in-Command, Maintenance Company, CFB Gagetown; Trials Officer, Land Forces Trials and Evaluations Unit, CFB Gagetown; G4 Combat Training Centre HQ, Gagetown; Battery Commander, HQ & Svcs Bty, 4 Air Defence Regiment, CFB Gagetown; Tactics Instructor and Chief Support, Tactics School CTC Gagetown; and Integrated Logistics Support Manager and Project Manager in Director General Land Equipment Program Management Ottawa. He retired from the Regular Force and joined the Reserve Force in 2010. His most recent employment was as Commanding Officer with 37 Service Battalion, Saint John NB where he has also filled the positions of Deputy Commanding Officer, Senior Logistics Operations Officer and the Officer Commanding 31 Combat Services Support Company.
