Cpl Richard-Dumont will retire from the Canadian Armed Forces (CAF) on January 13, 2019 after 8 years of service.

Cpl Richard-Dumont enlisted as a Vehicle Technician on November 5, 2009 from the recruiting center in Trois-Rivières, QC. Following his BMQ, he was sent to Borden to complete his QL3 training; upon completion, he was posted to 5 Svc Bn to complete his QL4. Once in Valcartier, Cpl Richard-Dumont decided to leave the CAF to return to his former civilian employment. Then in 2014, he decided to re-enlist in the CAF and completed his QL4 package at 2 PPCLI in CFB Shilo. In March 2015, Cpl Richard-Dumont completed his QL5 course and remained at CFB Shilo, where he worked at Base Maintenance and was fortunate enough to participate in Op LENTUS twice, once for the Saskatchewan Fires and again for the Winnipeg Floods. In 2017, he was posted to 202 Workshop Depot in Montreal, where he worked on several LAV 6.0 of the up armoring project as well as preparing previously deployed vehicles for domestic use. Cpl Richard-Dumont decided to not renew his contract and will be retiring from the CAF to return to his hometown in the region of Mauricie and resume his employment as a logging trucker.
