RCEME GUILD VOLUNTARY DONATION CAMPAIGN**

BACKGROUND

 - c. The RCEME Guild-General Fund. Donations will be allocated to benefits offered by the RCEME Guild.


METHOD OF DONATING

3. All donations must be completed through the RCEME Corps website at <http://rcemecorpsgemrc.ca/rceme-guild/donate/>. Donations can be made using a credit card (Visa or Mastercard), cheque, cash or electronic transfer. The website provides the necessary details on each option.
4. Follow the following steps to donate through an e-transfer:
 - a. Go to the RCEME Guild donation page and enter your personal information and the amount you wish to donate;
 - b. Select the payment method: Cheque/E-transfer or Credit Card. Enter all the necessary information; and

c. Confirm the transfer.

5. Tax Receipts. All donations of \$10 or more are fully tax deductible. Tax receipts will be issued in the name of the RCEME Guild and sent to individual donors for use in the applicable tax year.
