Capt Germain J.G. Boudreault, CD

Capt Germain Boudreault will retire on 15 September 2019 after 34 years of service with the Canadian Armed Forces (CAF) and the RCEME Corps.

Capt Germain Boudreault is a native of Anse St-Jean, Quebec. He enrolled in the Canadian Forces in September 1985. Upon completion of basic, language and technical training, he was posted to Canadian Forces School of Electrical and Mechanical Engineering (CFSEME) in Borden where he completed his training as a Fire Control System (FCS) Technician within the Electrical Mechanical Engineering (EME) Branch.

Capt Boudreault was posted to Base Maintenance, Gagetown, from 1987-1990, for the completion of level 4 trades training before being posted to Baden Soellingen Germany with 3e Bataillon Royal Canadian Regiment (3 RCR), from 1990-1993, where he served as IC, Fire Control System Section.

He deployed on Operation Desert Shield, where he was in charge of maintaining fire control equipment's for the Canadian Contingent located in Qatar. Capt Boudreault was posted to 210 Air Defense Workshop, Chatham, NB in 1993, where he served in FCS Section.

He was responsible of maintaining the Air Defense Anti-Tank System (ADATS) Fleets.

Upon promotion to the rank of Master-Corporal, he was posted to 5e Régiment d'artillerie Légère du Canada (5 RALC), Valcartier in 1996, where he assumed the function of IC FCS Section. Capt Boudreault was also deployed on United Nation Support Mission in Haïti (UNSMIH) from Oct 1996-Apr 1997.

In 1999, Capt Boudreault was posted back to Base Maintenance, Gagetown, where he was in charge of maintaining Artillery School Fire Control Equipment.

Promoted to the rank of Sergeant, Capt Boudreault was posted to 1st Regiment Royal Canadian Horse Artillery (1 RCHA), Shilo, MB in 2001, where he served in Light Maintenance Troop (LMT) in the capacity of IC, FCS Section and Control Officer, as well as being assigned the duty of Unit Radiation Safety Officer until he was promoted to the rank of Warrant Officer in June of 2005.

Capt Boudreault was posted to Royal Canadian Artillery School (RCAS), Gagetown, where he performed the duty of Electronic/Optronics (EO) Standard Officer and Maintenance Training Battery, Electronic Troop Warrant Officer. He deployed to Afghanistan in fall of 2007 as part of Technical Aids Visit (TAV) for the installation and upgrade of the M777 Gun Management System.

Promoted to the rank of Master Warrant Officer, Capt Boudreault was posted to the Director General Major Project Delivery (DGMPD), M777 Howitzer Project in 2008, where he assumed the function of Subject Matter Expert (SME) Fire Control System. Summer 2012, he was posted to Director General Land Equipment Program Management (DGLEPM) as LCMM for the Protector Remote Weapon System (RWS).

Promoted to the rank of CWO in June 2013, he was posted to Winnipeg as the 17 Wing Logistic and Engineering Branch CWO. Promoted to his current rank under the Special Requirements Commission Plan (SRCP) in July 2016, Capt Boudreault was posted to the Director Land Equipment Programs Staff (DLEPS) Office in Ottawa.

Germain and his spouse Rita will remain in the Gatineau Area. His last day in uniform is on 19 July and he will commence work with the Night Vision Modernisation Project on 8 Aug 19. He wishes to pass on his gratitude to the RCEME Corps and all of the people he had the privilege to serve with over his career.
