## MESSAGE DE RETRAITE



**MWO Luc Sévigny, CD**

After 29 years of loyal service within the RCEME corps and the CAF, MWO Luc Sévigny will retire on October 8, 2019, his last day at work will be September 3, 2019.

MWO Sévigny was born in Vimont Laval in the province of Quebec. In 1985, he submitted his first application to enlist in the CAF with an YTEP type contract as Gunner 021 at the end of May 2006 returned to the civilian to get his GD in mechanics. In 1991 he enlisted but this time as a vehicle technician.

He trained as a basic driver and NQ3 ELM at CFB Borden and CFB St-Jean-sur-Richelieu. After completing his NQ3, he got transferred to 1 Svc Bn of Canada at CFB Calgary. He remained there until 1996 while completing his NQ5 in 1995 and was promoted to the rank of Corporal.

In July 1996, he got transferred to 5 RGC and deployed to Operation Ice 1998 and Bosnia in 2001 just after the World Trade Center attacks. Returning from Bosnia in March 2002, he got transferred to 12 RBC in July 2002. He remained at 12 RBC until July 2007. First deployment to Afghanistan from November 2006 to July 2007 and promoted to the rank of Master Corporal after his return.

From July 2007 to June 2011 he got transferred to 1R22R. During this period, he deployed to the UAE in 2008 for 2 months and returned to two other full missions in Afghanistan in the summer of 2009 as Sgt (acting) and in the fall of 2010, as Sgt.

Rumors were beginning to run that he had bought land there. Returning from Afghanistan, transferred to Canada's 5th Svc Bn for a one-year period with the 35 Svc Bn as Sgt production. In July 2012, his career manager had other plans for him so he got transferred from Quebec to Petawawa for a period of 3 years, during this period he deployed to Philippines in October 2013 for 2 months on a humanitarian aid operation as Typhoon Yolanda caused several damages to the area.

Promoted to Warrant Officer in July 2015 he then transferred to Ottawa for 202 DA in Uplands at the Land Engineering Support Centre (LESC). In the summer of 2017, he was missing the armoured corps so he asked to return to 12 RBC, Quebec, as Control Warrant. He was promoted to the rank of MWO on Dec. 1. 2018 and transferred to his current position as of April 10, 2019 over at 5 Svc Bn.

MWO Sévigny plans to stay in the Quebec City area with his wife Nathalie and visit his two daughters Audrey and Kathleen, both residents of the Gaspésie region, more often.

At his request, there will be no DWD but Luc wishes to convey his thanks and appreciation to all the exceptional people with whom he has had the chance to work during his career.
