MWO Mike Tintor

After 34 years of loyal service to the CAF and RCEME Corps, MWO Mike Tintor will retire on 11 September, 2019, with his last day of work being 21 August, 2019.

In 1985 MWO Tintor enrolled in the Reserves as an Infantryman. He deployed with 1 RCR to Norway in 1986 for, what was then, Canada's contribution to NATO's Rapid Response Force.

In 1993 MWO Tintor component transferred to the Regular Force and was posted to 2 PPCLI, Winnipeg. He deployed with the Battalion to Bosnia in 1997, as part of SFOR. Shortly after returning from tour he remustered to ELM Tech and was posted to Kingston to attend the POET course.

After POET, and his QL3 in Borden, he was posted to Base Maintenance Winnipeg. During his time there he completed his QL4 OJT package, returned to Borden for his QL5 and, he was able to deploy to the Golan Heights with UNDOF.

In 2004 he was promoted to MCpl and posted to CFSEME as an instructor until 2009, when he was promoted to Sgt and posted to 1RCHA, Shilo. He deployed to Afghanistan in 2011 with the Mission Closure Unit to help close down Canada's presence in Kandahar.

In 2012 MWO Tintor was promoted to WO and posted to Base Maintenance, Shilo, for one year followed by a posting to 17 Wing, Winnipeg, in 2013.

During the last 6 years in Winnipeg he was promoted to MWO, spent a few months at 1 Cdn Div HQ, and most recently was the ETQMS of 17 Wing with Mission Support Squadron. His final deployment, as the 17 Wing Nijmegen team 2IC, in July 19, helped close out a long and fulfilling career.

Mike has not gone far from the RCEME troops though, he accepted a position with the public service and continues to work in the same building near them. Mike would like to thank everyone who has helped him during his career as he would not be where he is without their support and mentoring. Mike has decided that there will no formal DWD.
