Maj Aingkaran Sridaran

After 11 years of loyal service within the RCEME corps and the CAF, Maj Aingkaran Sridaran will retire on 30 September, 2019.

Major Sridaran joined the CAF in 2008 as a Direct Entry Officer following his education at the University of Toronto. After completing Basic Training, Common Army Training and RCEME trade training, he was posted to CFB Petawawa as Officer In Charge of Weapons & Electronics Platoon at Maintenance Coy, 2 Svc Bn. In 2011, following his promotion to the rank of Capt, he was posted to The Royal Canadian Dragoons, as their Maintenance Officer. In 2013, he was posted to the 2nd Canadian Mechanized Brigade Group headquarters as G4-Maint. In 2015, he was posted to Ottawa to work within Director Land Equipment Program Management as a staff officer. In 2016, Capt Sridaran was selected to attend the Advanced Ammunition Engineering post grad program at the Royal Military College in Kingston. Following his education, in 2017, he was promoted to the rank of Major and posted back to Ottawa as a Project Manager at Director Ammunition and Explosives Management and Engineering.

Maj Sridaran has accepted a public servant position and will continue his work in the field of ammunition and explosives, supporting the CAF. He will be staying in the Ottawa area with his wife Laveni and his children Pakalavi and Kuttralen. Aingkaran leaves the CAF with only good memories of the soldiers he had the privilege of knowing.
