After 30 years of service with the Canadian Armed Forces (CAF) and the Corps of Royal Canadian Electrical and Mechanical Engineers (RCEME) as an Electronic-Optronics Technician (EO Tech), MWO Brown will retire on 23/10/2019.

MWO Brown joined the CAF on 2 May 1989 in Peterborough, Ontario. After completing Basic Recruit Training at CFB Cornwallis, he continued onto Kingston to complete P.O.E.T Training.
