After 23 years of service with the Canadian Armed Forces (CAF) and the Corps of Royal Canadian Electrical and Mechanical Engineers (RCEME), Master Warrant Officer (MWO) Armstrong will retire on 26 June 2020.

MWO Armstrong joined the Canadian Armed Forces (CAF) in Brantford Ontario on 19 September 1996 as a reserve vehicle technician with the 56th Field Artillery Regiment. In February 1999 he component transferred to the Regular Force and was posted to the Canadian Forces School of Electrical and Mechanical Engineering in Borden. From there MWO Armstrong was posted to many army units including 2 Service Battalion, 2 Field Ambulance, 2nd Battalion of the Royal Canadian Regiment and the Royal Canadian Dragoons. During his vast career MWO Armstrong also deployed on overseas deployments to Bosnia, Lebanon and twice to Afghanistan.

MWO Armstrong is an extremely knowledgeable and dedicated member of the CAF. He consistently puts the welfare of his soldiers on the top of his priority list. MWO Armstrong is also a very fit CAF member completing the Iron Warrior competition in Petawawa on more than one occasion. Upon his retirement he will transition over to work as a civilian contractor with Calian working with the Department of National Defence. He will also join the training cadre at 33 Service Battalion as a class A reserve member.
