## RETIREMENT MESSAGE

### Capt Fournier, CD

After 14 years of service with the Canadian Armed Forces (CAF) and the Corps of Royal Canadian Electrical and Mechanical Engineers (RCEME), Capt Fournier will retire on 15 July 2020.

Capt Fournier joined the CAF on 3 June 2006 and attended the Royal Military College of Canada (RMC) in Kingston from 2006-2010, graduating with a Bachelor's Degree of Electrical Engineering. After completing RCEME Officer training in 2011, he was posted to 202 Workshop Depot in Montreal as a Project Officer and was subsequently employed as the Strategic Planning Officer. From September 2013 to July 2014, Capt Fournier attended the Ammunition Technical Officer (ATO) course at RMC in Kingston and at the Canadian Forces Logistics Training Center (CFLTC) in Borden. Upon completion of the ATO course, he was posted to Defence Research and Development Canada (DRDC) in Valcartier as the Explosives Safety Officer. In 2016, Capt Fournier was selected to attend the Advanced Ammunition Engineering post graduate program at RMC in Kingston. Once he obtained his Master's Degree in 2017, Capt Fournier was posted to Ottawa as a Qualified Ammunition Technical Authority within the Director Ammunition and Explosives Management and Engineering (DAEME). In 2019, he was posted to 2 Service Battalion in Petawawa as the second in command of Administration Company.

Capt Fournier has accepted a public servant position with DAEME and will return to Ottawa to work in the field of ammunition and explosives.

A Departure with Dignity (DWD) Ceremony is not planned at this time. We hope to celebrate his service and bid him farewell during an informal luncheon mid-June.
