## RETIREMENT MESSAGE



**Cpl Jordan Dixon**

After 5 years of Loyal Service with the Royal Canadian Electrical and Mechanical Engineers (RCEME) as a Vehicle Technician, Cpl Dixon will retire from the Canadian Armed Forces (CAF) on 1 June 2020.

Cpl Jordan Dixon joined the Canadian Forces as a Rifleman for the 1 R NB Regt in Fredericton in May of 2010. He continued to complete his P Res BMQ in the summer of 2010. After spending a couple of years in the Reserve Force and working civilian side he decided to take the plunge and join the Regular Force, so in February of 2015 he joined the Reg Force and soon after reported to CFB Borden, CFSEME for his new journey of a RCEME Tech within apprentice Pl.

In the summer of 2015, Cpl Dixon was posted to 5 CDSB Gagetown and in September 2015 went back to CFB Borden for his RCEME DP1 Veh Tech course. After completing his DP1 in April 2016 he returned back to CFB Gagetown to begin his OJT package.

Cpl Dixon finished his OJT package and went back to complete his DP2 in March 2018. After completing his DP2 he was employed within a couple different Maint Sections within 5 CDSB Gagetown Maint Coy. Spring of 2019 he decided to test himself with a LEO 2 Maint course, which was followed by a posting to RCD C Sqn Det Gagetown July 2019 until release. He plans on staying
