c. extend the bursary deadline from 21 July 2023 to 25 August 2023 in order to allow more time for submissions.

Once members leave the school, there is no visibility on members continuing to pay after the one year as they are not tracked. Col Raymond proposed no change. Col Gauthier concurred, as stated that absorbing the small cost of initial accoutrements is simpler than trying to formulate a complex method for Reserve member payments.
